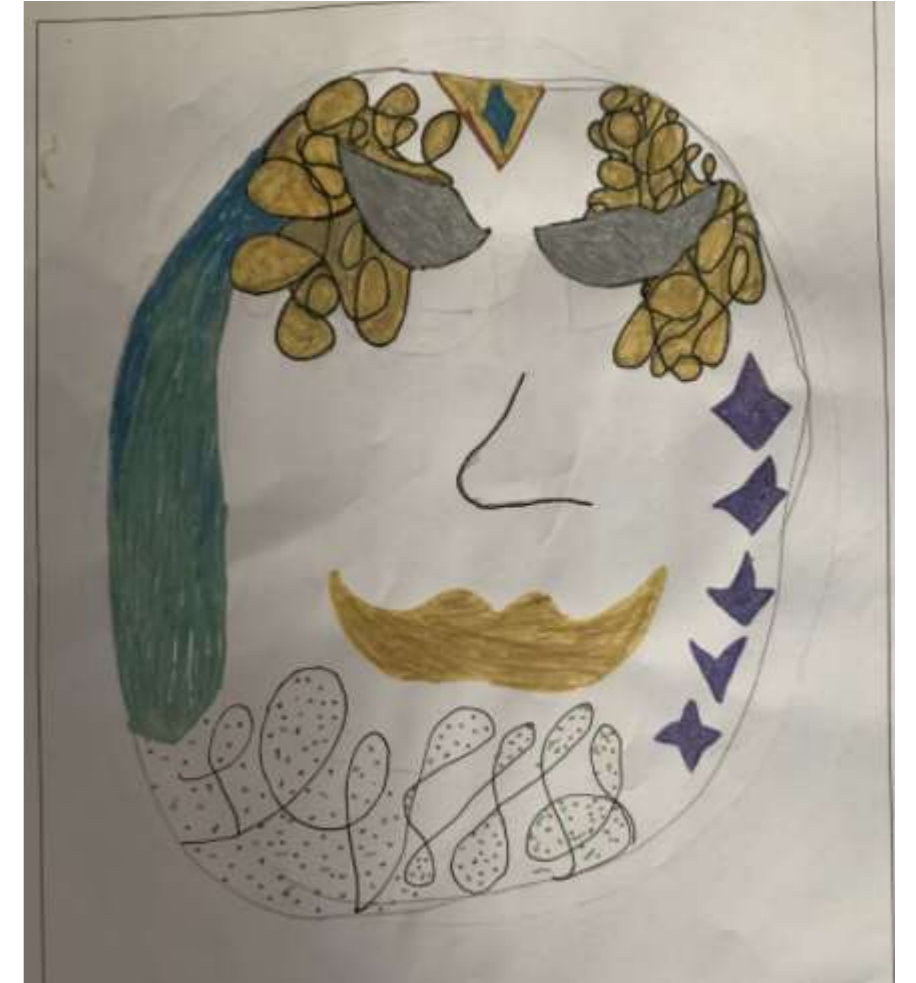


Here is a selection of some brilliant work produced by Spotted Owl class this week.

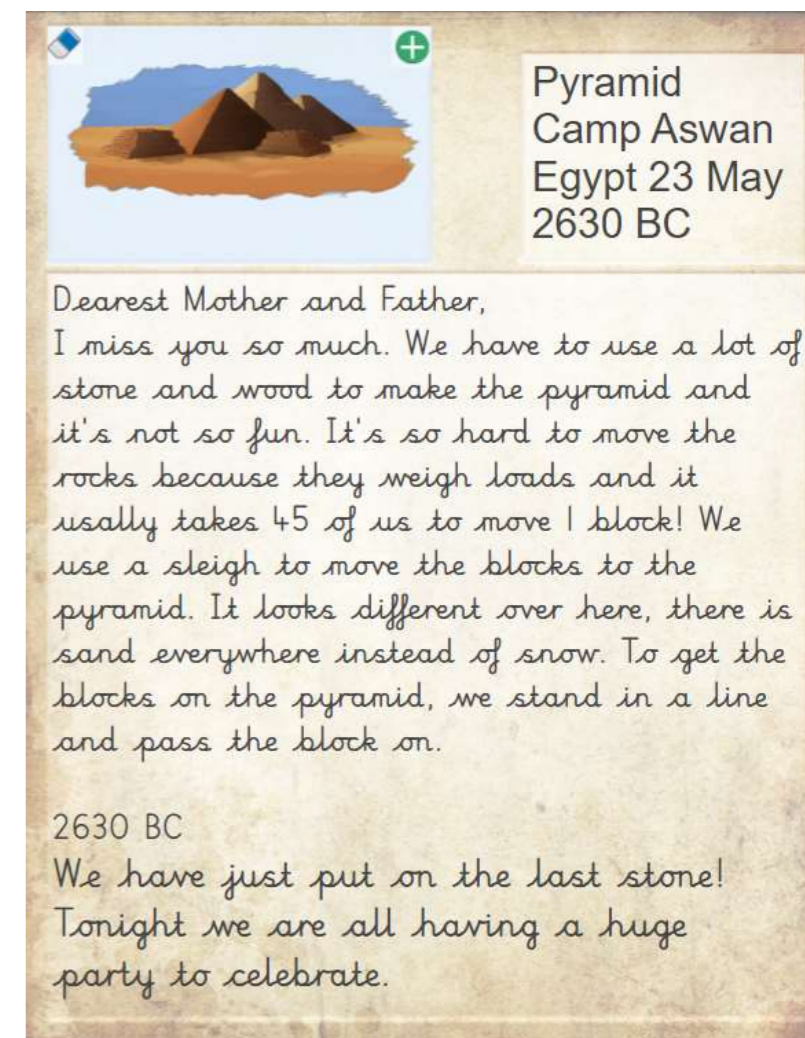
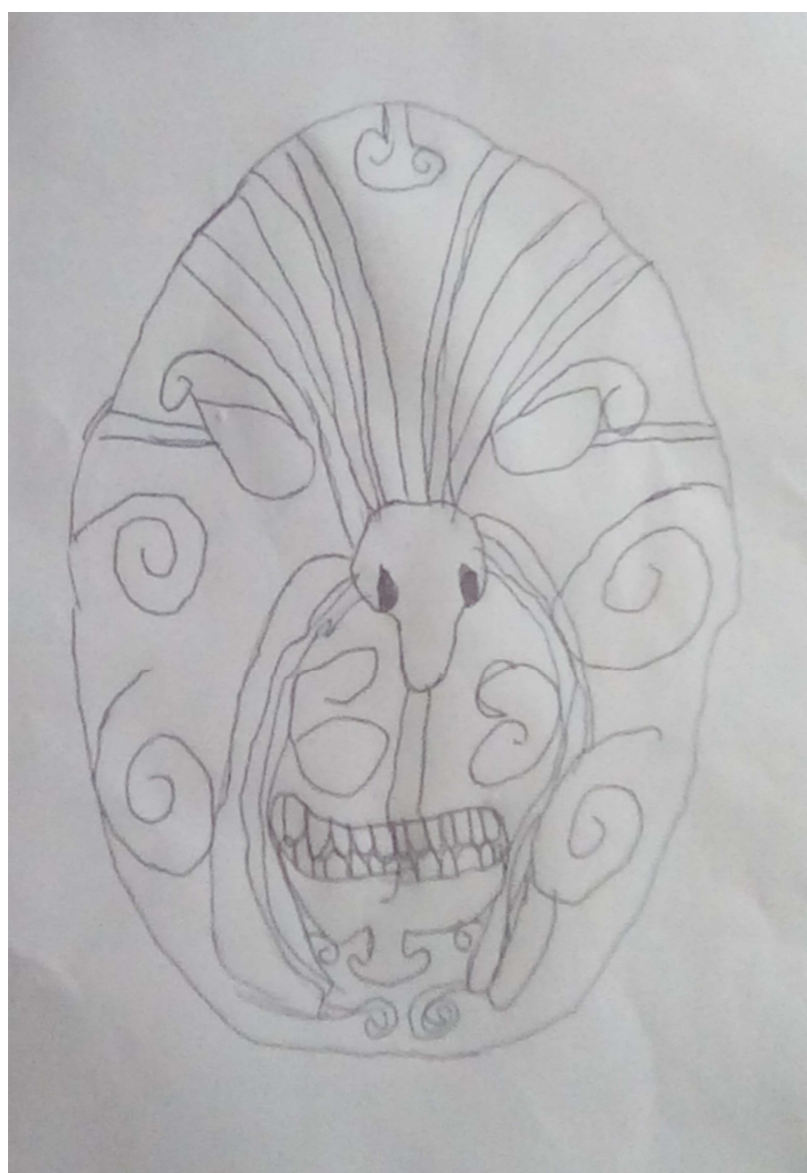
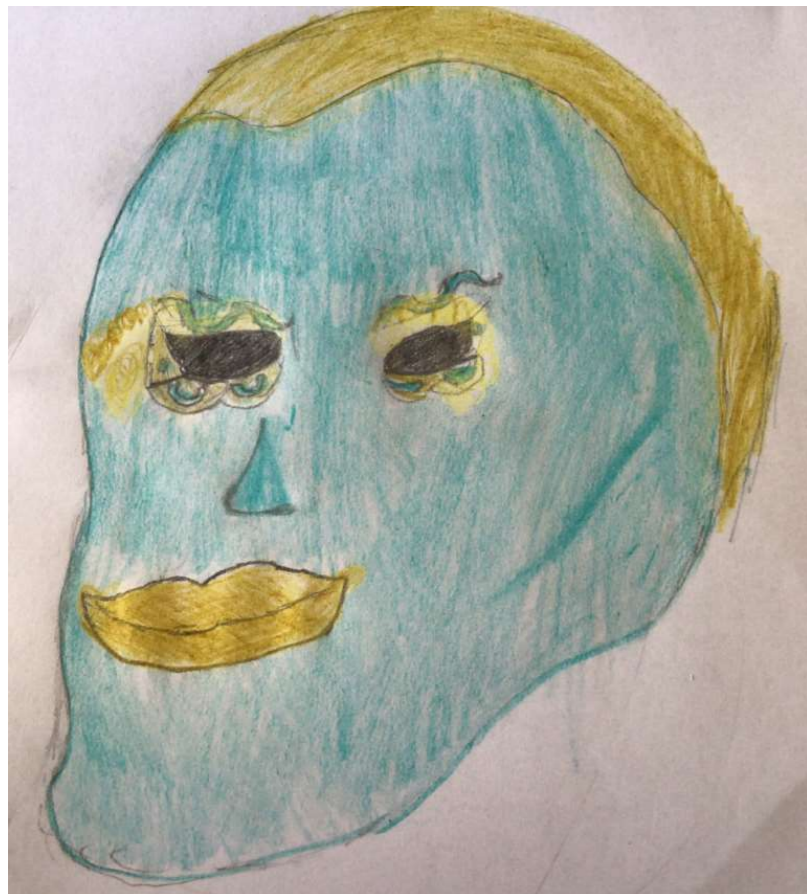
Art - Ancient Egyptian Death Masks.
