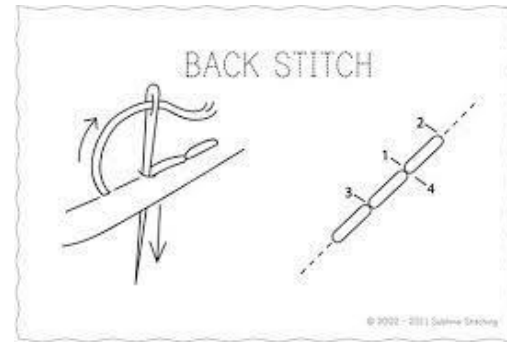
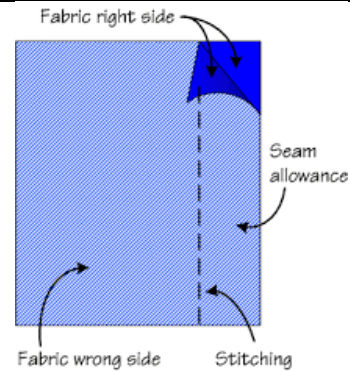




## Crofton Junior School – DT Knowledge Organiser – Heroes and Villains – Year 5 Summer Term

<b>Overview of the Unit of Work</b>	Pupils will learn how to create a Viking cushion using textiles skills for both Art and DT. They will use stitching techniques and look at the qualities of materials.
<b>Prior Learning &amp; Vocabulary</b>	During the Spring Term of Year 4, pupils will have looked at textiles from an Art and DT perspective whilst making Egyptian cushions.  <b>Vocabulary:</b> design, make, evaluate, technical, purposeful, appealing, criteria, generate, develop, model, communicate, ideas, templates, tools, practical, materials, components, construction, product, purpose, inspiration, features, materials, technique, intended user, stitch, dye
<b>Sticky Knowledge</b>	Pupils will learn: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To create a cushion that employs a seam allowance.</li><li>• To join textiles with a combination of stitching techniques such backstitch for seams and running stitch to attach decoration.</li><li>• To use the qualities of materials to create suitable visual and tactile effects in the decoration of textiles – such as soft decoration for comfort.</li><li>• To show precision when using their stitching techniques.</li><li>• To be able to choose from a range of stitching techniques and use them appropriately.</li><li>• To use combined previous learned techniques to create a cushion.</li></ul>



**New Vocabulary**

seam – a line where two pieces of fabric are sewn together  
 allowance – to allow for something  
 backstitch – to stitch backwards to create a secure line of thread where there are no gaps  
 running stitch – to stitch forward where there can be gaps  
 tactile – the feel of something  
 precision – the accuracy of something
