Dear Diary,

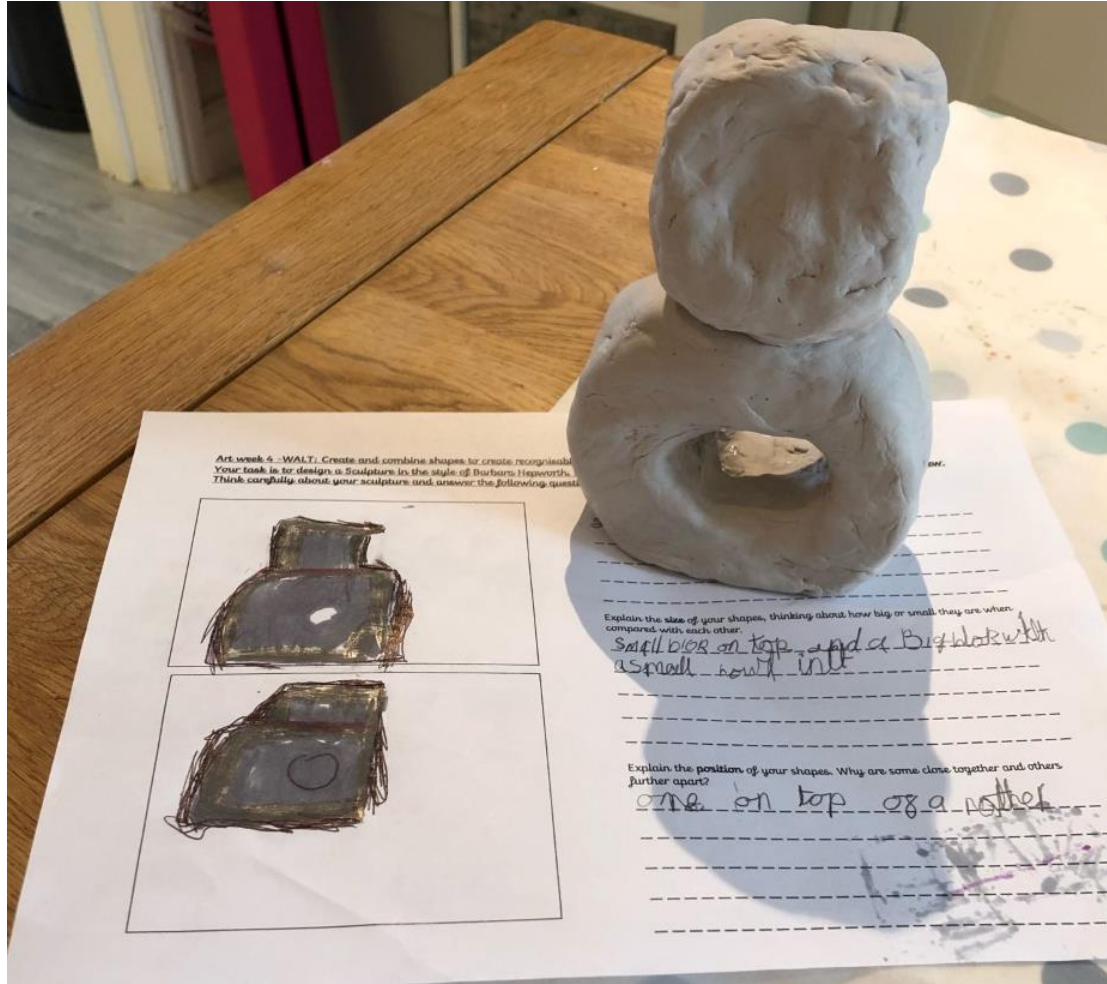

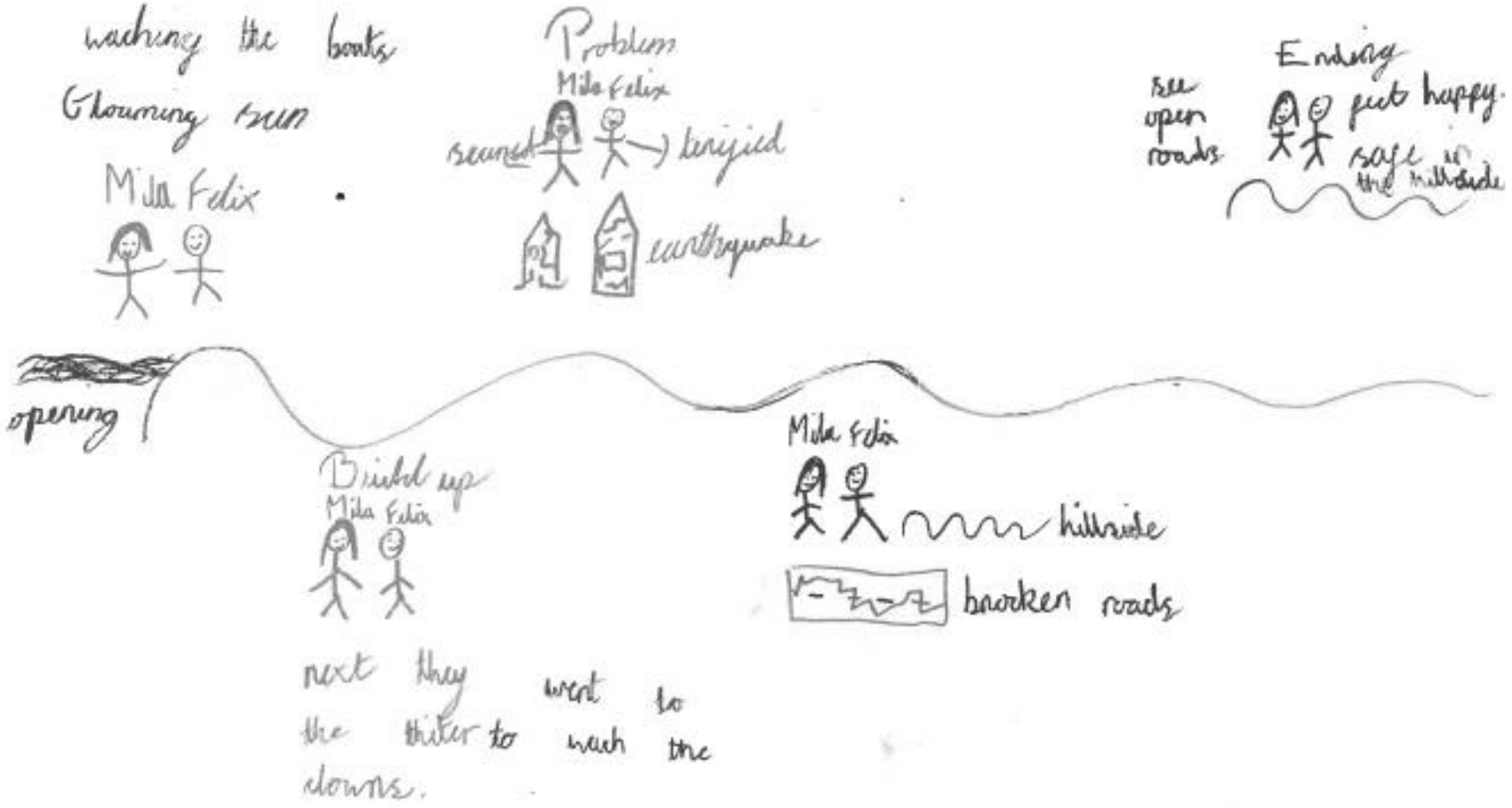


Task - to design and create a sculpture, inspired by the work of Barbara Hepworth, focusing on curve and the use of holes.



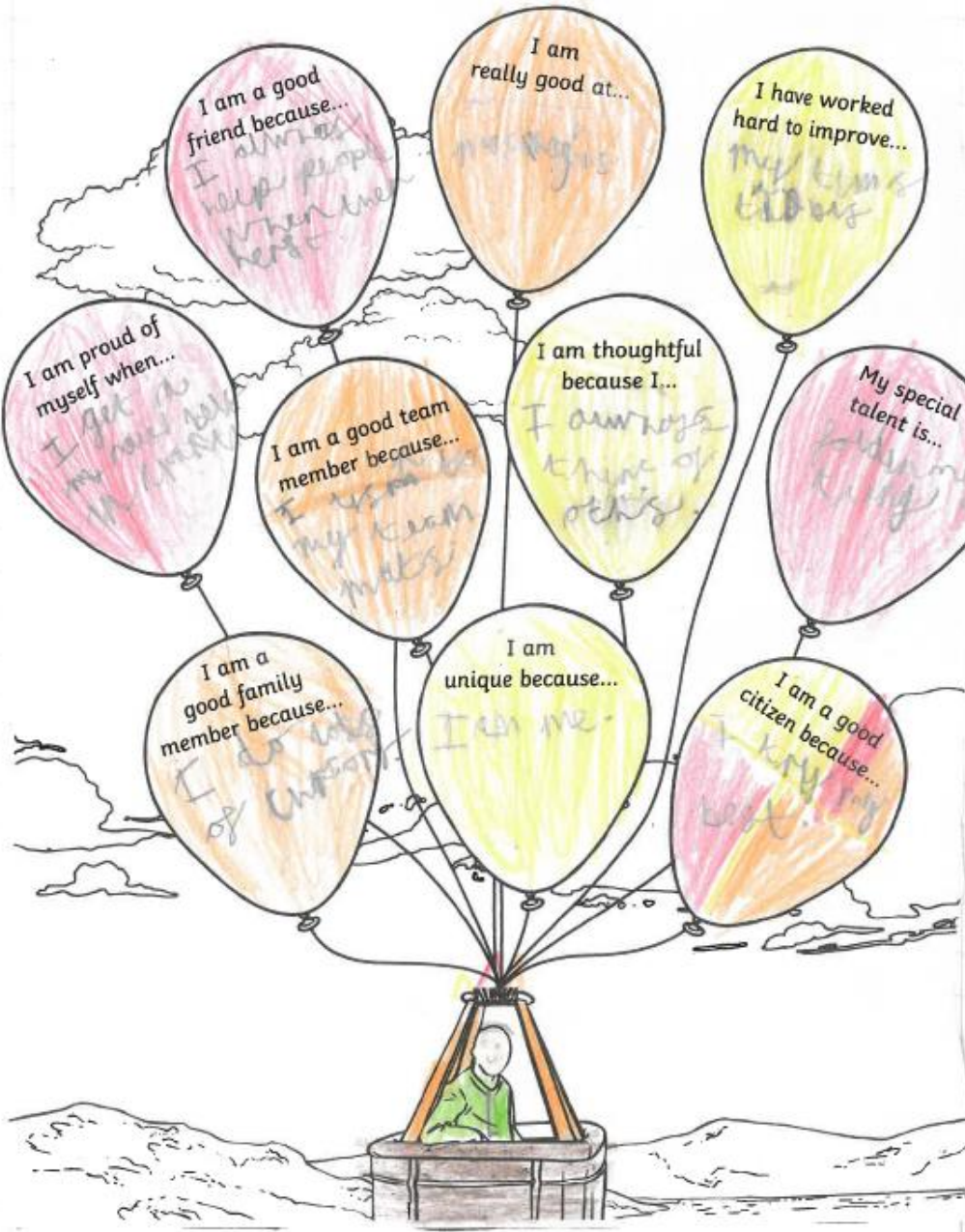
This pupil wanted to share the volcano that he made with his granddad out of card, paper mâché and paint.

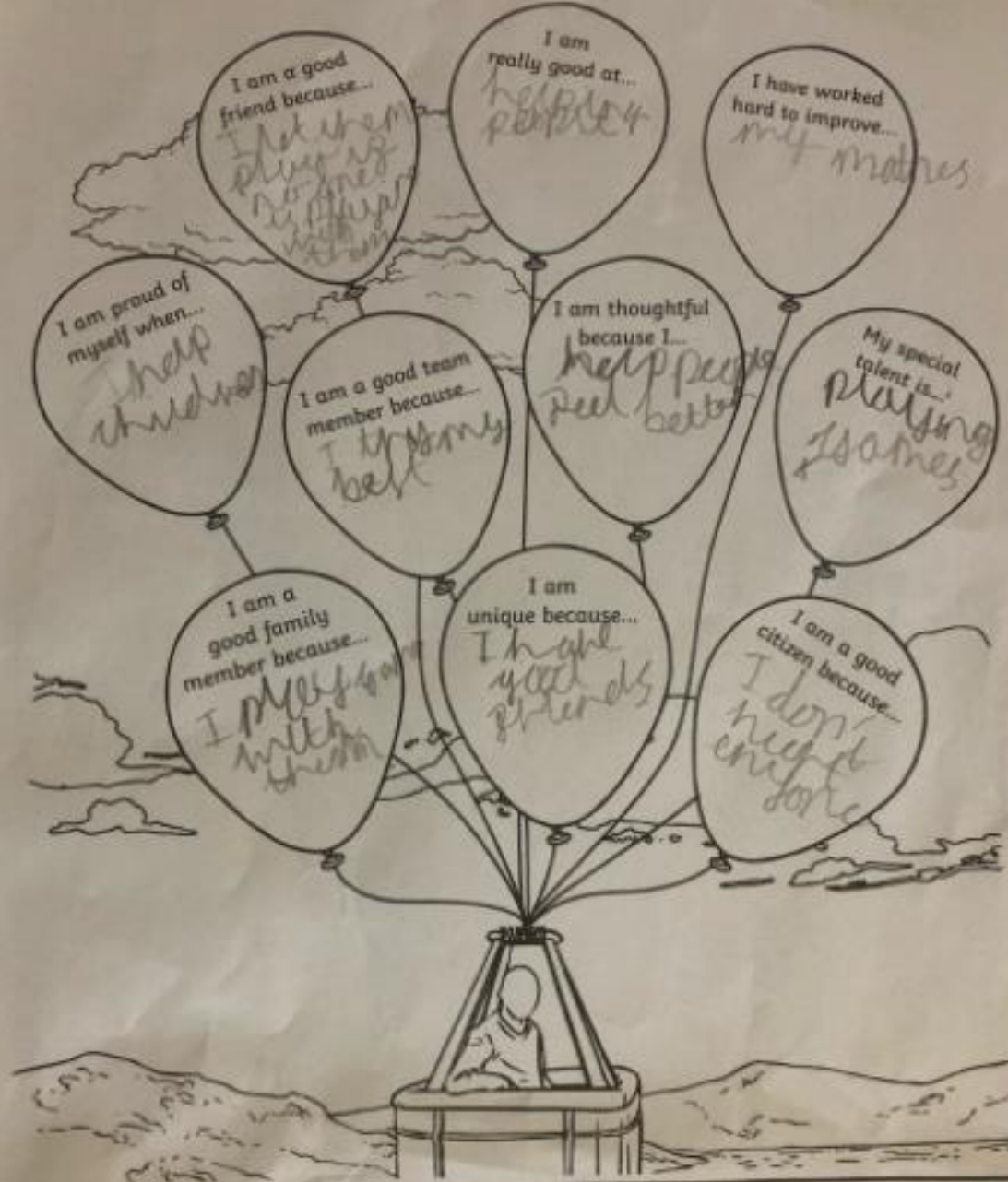

Your task is to draw and label your sculpture with the tools and materials you are going to use to create it. Then explain why you have chosen the materials and tools to make your sculpture.

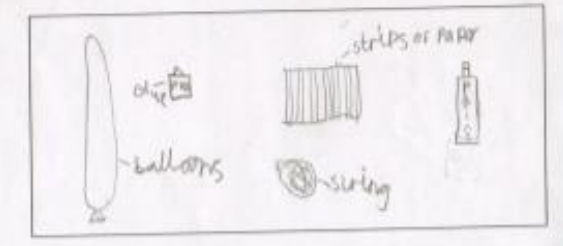

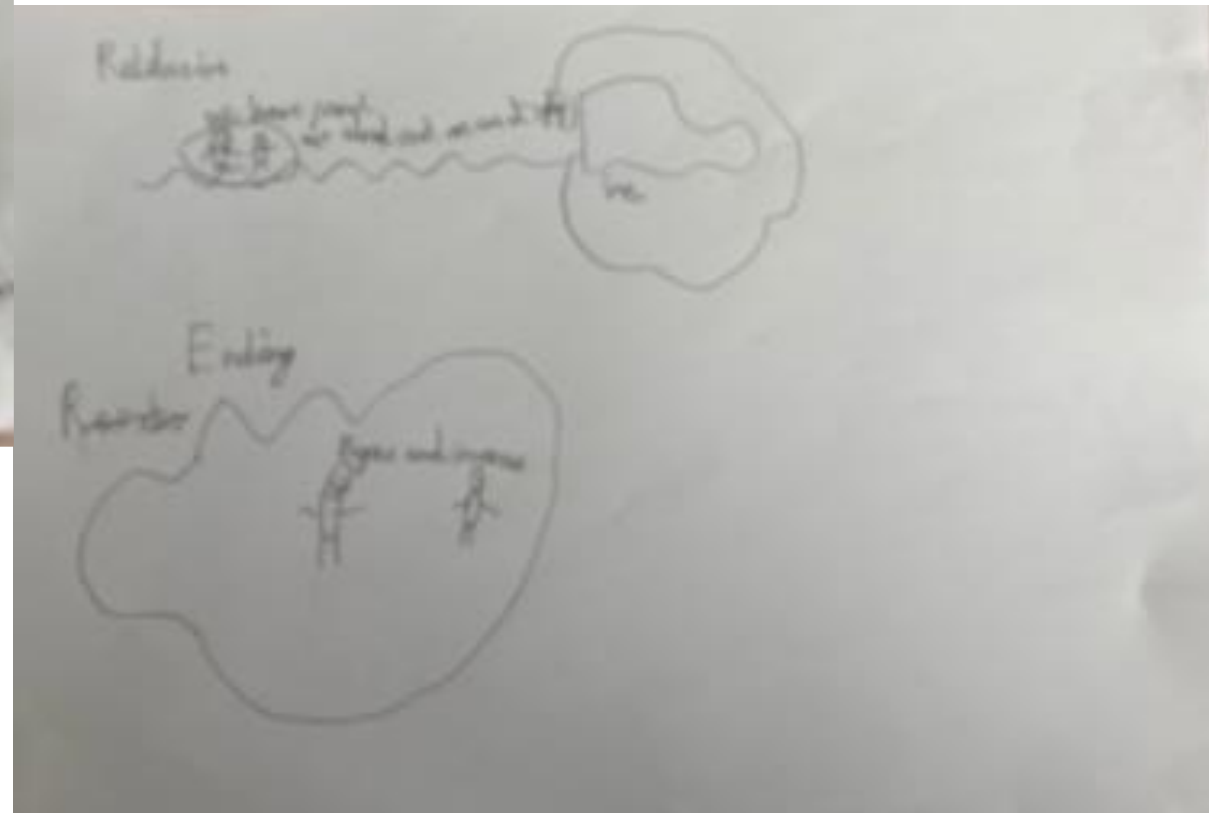


Sculpture art work inspired by Barbara Hepworth.



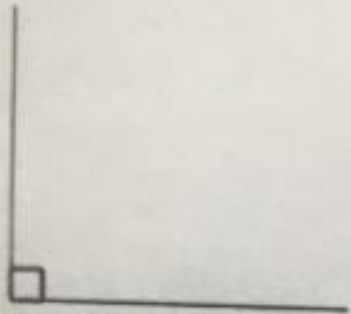
Story snake map.

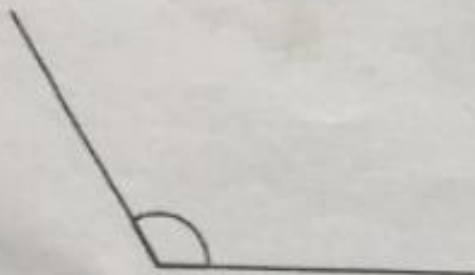

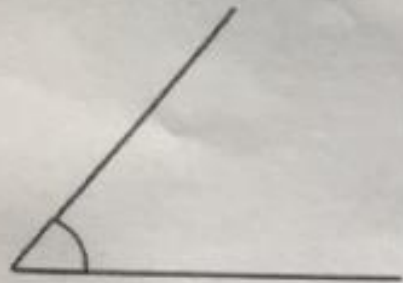

**Right Angle** - a square  $90^\circ$ .





