line, shape, colour, form, texture, pattern, direction, scale, orientation

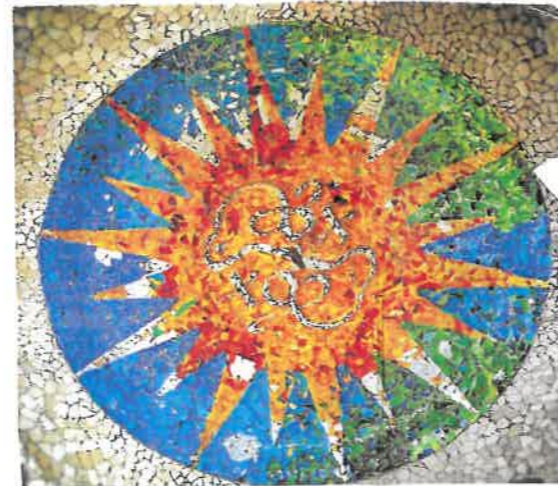
I really like 'The dragon' because the tiles are broken into pieces, creating a scaly look.



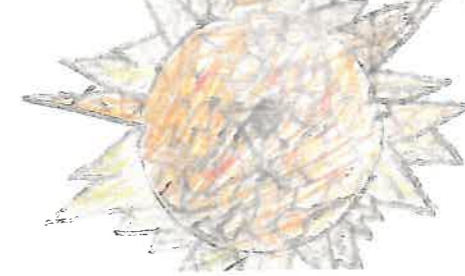
The technique he used was called trencadis.
