Christian beliefs

Christians believe in God because that is their religion. They believe he has long, white flowing hair, golden robes and a golden sash. God may be somebody's belief because they were brought up with a religious family or background. They might also believe in him from answered prayers and people being good.



God

Reasons to believe: Beautiful images are/could be created by God. If a good thing happens in your life, God also could have done that.

Reasons: not to believe: If a loved member of your family is ill and instead of getting better they have passed away, you may not believe in God.

Agnostic

If you are: Agnostic, you don't know whether to believe in a religion. You may just believe in God and Science.

Atheist

If you are: Atheist, you do not believe in God at all. You will just believe in Science.

Theist

If you are: Theist, you have a religion and believe in God not Science.
