Built in 1450's by the indigenous people (the Incas).

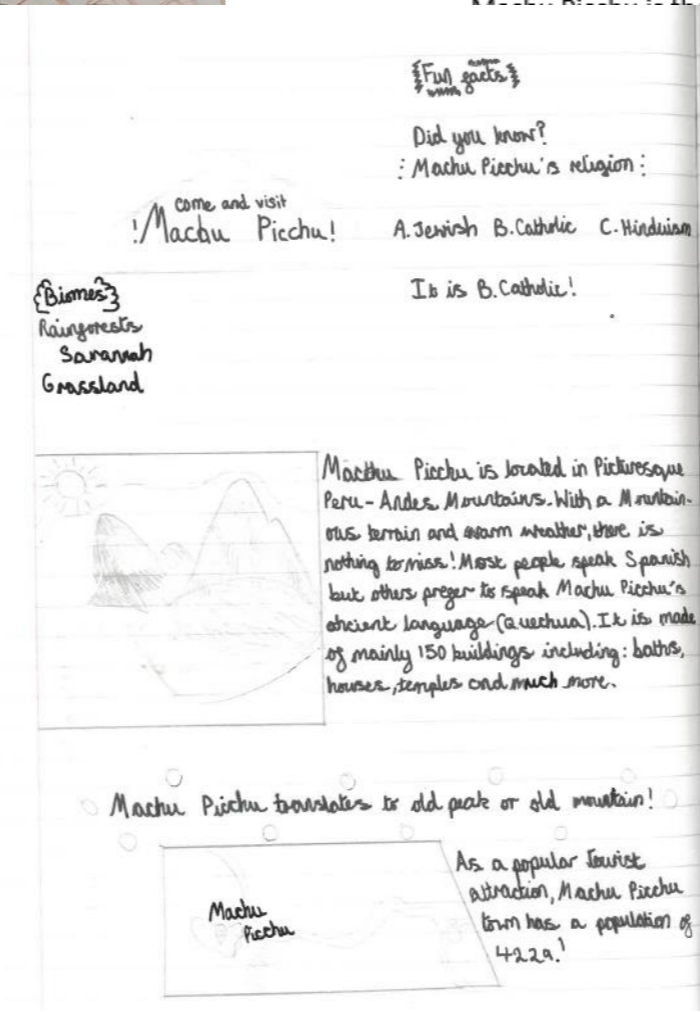
Machu Picchu is thought to be the emperor's palace and of great individual
