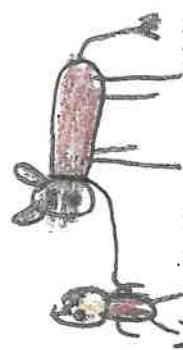


Year 4 - Why is Jesus inspiring to some people?

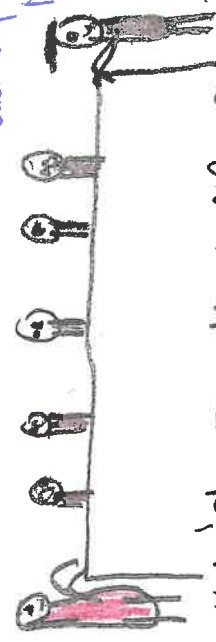
Learning more about features of religions (e.g. celebrations) in order to reflect on the significance (A1)
