Written explanations of their knowledge of living things

Animals eat different things. Some animals eat meat which are called carnivores. Some animals eat only plants so they are called herbivores and some animals eat meat and plants. They are called omnivores.

Carnivores and Omnivores are important to any ecosystem, as they keep other species from overpopulating. All animals acquire energy from food they eat. Depending on a type of animal, this food may consist of plants, animals, or a combination of both. Carnivores of the animal world, have very defined canine teeth for tearing at meat, combined with a sometimes limited number of molars. Because Omnivores eat both meat and plants, they have a combination of sharp front-teeth and molars for grinding. Herbivores only eat plants. They have molars that are strong, flat, and perfect for grinding a plant.
