### Covid-19 Outbreak Management Plan – April 2022

Government guidance states:

If your child has tested positive for Covid-19, they should:

- Try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days. This begins the day after the test was taken.
- Avoid meeting people at higher risk of Covid-19 for 10 days.

If your child has Covid-19 symptoms, and a high temperature or does not feel well enough to come to school, they should not do so. They should return to school when they feel well enough and do not have a high temperature.

We as a school are adhering to the guidance for members of staff.

We are advising that parents/carers and pupils adhere to the guidance; however, we recognise that we are unable to enforce it. If parents/carers wish for their child to attend school we will:

- Inform relevant members of staff
- Monitor for an increase in symptoms within the class and school

If we see a rise in known cases or the named symptoms we will:

- Inform parents/carers in order to monitor their child(ren) at home
- Remind parents/carers of the government guidance and request that this is followed
- Take further advice from Wakefield Public Health professionals
