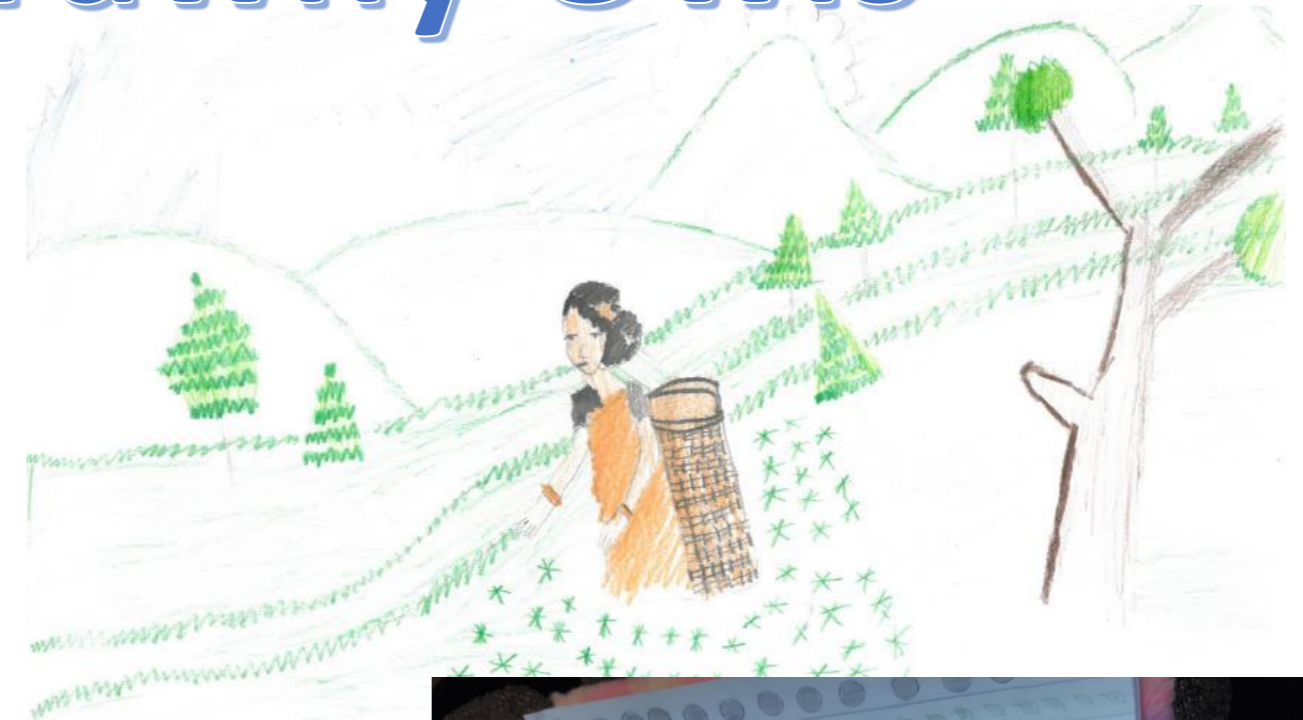
On

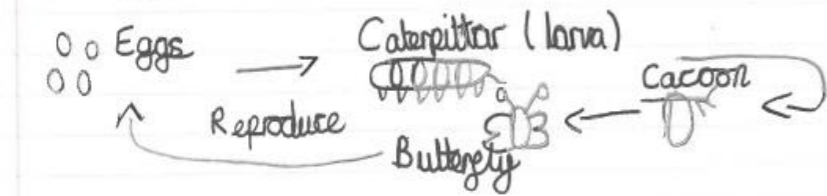

Kangaroo: marsupial Butterfly

Life cycle:

Egg
A butterfly starts as an egg and when it hatches it's a caterpillar. A caterpillar is classed as a larva. It will grow a cocoon (pupa) while going through complete metamorphosis and will come out as a butterfly.

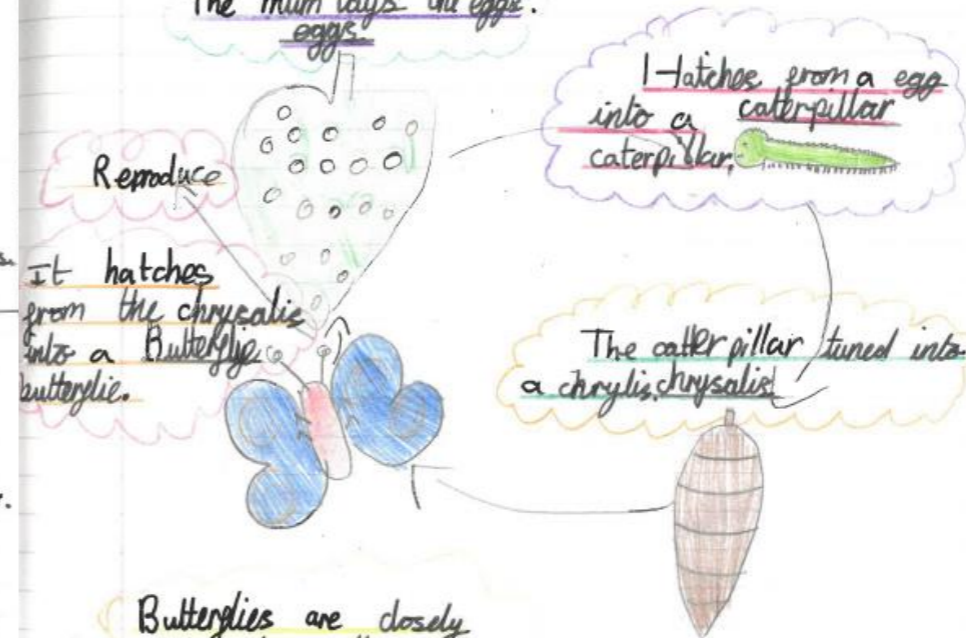
